OUR FOUNDER

Building a World Where Every Girl Belongs



When I founded M4C Foundation — Muslimahs For Change — I had one simple belief: that every girl, regardless of where she was born, deserves access to safety, education, and opportunity.

What started as a dream in Dallas, TX has grown into a movement that spans three countries — serving orphans in **Uganda**, supporting girls in **Kenya**, and empowering the next generation of Muslim women leaders right here in DFW.

In just two years we have served over 1,000 beneficiaries, **raised \$80,000**, fed orphans during Ramadan and Eid, built water wells in rural Uganda, provided sanitary pads so girls don't miss school, and opened the doors of Sakina Home for Girls in Kenya.

This is just the beginning. In 2026 we are launching **CodeHerForward** — a free **STEM** weekend for girls ages 12–17 — and expanding **Sakina Home** to serve 150 girls. We are building a future where no Muslim girl is left behind.
